## Creating mobile codes

Select what information you want to encode: a website link, some text, or a phone number to dial, and turn it into a mobile code, a code that can be scanned using a camera phone.

Simply start typing away the text you want converted and watch the mobile code being generated instantly. Once done, name it in any way you want and scan, print or save it for sharing the way you choose best.

### Generate your mobile code (Datamatrix)

- Text
- Dial

Try not to exceed 60 characters of text, as the mobile code starts getting too complex for camera phones to handle. Use short URLs, if possible. There are various online services that shorten long URLs. Visit, for example, [TinyURL](#) or [SnipURL](#) for more information.
